

A Guide to year-end undergraduate student surveys from Dr. Errington:

1. CBE Senior Exit Survey: the CE program would like you to complete the exit survey located here, <http://www.cbe.buffalo.edu/undergrad/exitSurvey.jsp>. I have contacted you previously about this. If you have not completed it, please do so. If you have submitted a response, please note that you can return to the survey at any time to edit/add to your responses. Many of the improvements we have made to the CE program over the past decade can be traced to suggestions provided by students.

2. SEAS Senior Survey: the dean's office would like you to complete the survey located here, <http://www.eng.buffalo.edu/seniorSurvey/form/>. You are likely to have received email messages from Prof. Van Benschoten regarding this survey. The graduating senior survey is an important means for us to track graduate school and job placement for our graduates. Please note that the dean's office disperses student volunteers on the day of commencement to track down students that have not completed the survey. They are afforded the same training credit collectors receive, so they will find you. If you complete the survey today, you will avoid this unpleasant situation.

3. Course evaluations: As we have requested in previous semesters, we would like you to complete evaluations associated with the courses you participated in this semester. They provide important feedback regarding the delivery of our courses. We can't fix a problem if we don't know about it (and we like to know what we're doing well too).
