Individual requests for deferral must be submitted in writing with your application. Persons reapplying for admission within one year of an original application are exempt from repayment of the fee.
- _____ C. **Test Scores:** Score reports for required standardized tests (**GRE and TOEFL**) must be officially submitted *directly* to the University at Buffalo by the testing agency. Xerox or student copies of reports are not acceptable. **Code for University at Buffalo is 2925.**
- _____ D. **Letters of Recommendation:** Request (3) persons who are familiar with your academic/research potential to write letters of recommendation and mail the completed forms *directly* to the Department.
- _____ E. **Statement of Purpose:** Prepare a brief (1-2 page) statement outlining past accomplishments, professional objectives, special interests and educational plans, and include it with your application.
- _____ F. **Financial Aid Form:** If you are applying from any foreign country, complete and return the International Applicant Financial Form with this application.

Application Deadlines: Completed applications including the application form and all academic credentials must be received prior to the following dates:

- Feb 1 of the same calendar year for fall admission.
- Oct 1 of the preceding calendar year for spring admission
